Real World Crew (RWC)

Youth are connected to academics and learning from real world experiences. We have developed this program to engage youth in learning by doing. We focus on life skills that teach critical thinking, team building, collaboration, communication and leadership.

The RWC will become a Youth Volunteer Crew that will do community service as our Youth Volunteer Crew.

Youth Volunteer Crew (YVC)

Participants engage with staff in age appropriate community service activities that they will plan and develop with creativity, as they become leaders. We make learning opportunities fun. Participants learn good work ethics while exploring careers and engaging in solving problems in our community.
